“The best part of every man’s education,” said Sir Walter Scott “is that which he gives himself”. The education received at school or college is but a beginning and is valuable chiefly because it trains the mind and makes it accustomed to continuous application of study. That which is put into us by other is always far less than ours which we acquire by our own efforts. Knowledge conquered by labour becomes a possession — a property entirely our own. Our own active effort is the essential thing and no facilities, no books, no teachers, no amount of lessons learn by rote will enable us to do without it.

The best teachers have always emphasised the importance of self-culture and of stimulating the students to gain knowledge by the exercise of his own faculties. They have relied more upon ‘training’ than upon ‘telling’ and have tried to make their pupils active partners in the work of their own education.
